

Requirements for No-name quilt.

Background fabric.

BLOCKS

If you embark on the full size quilt you will need:

Fabric for 60 blocks cut at approximately 11 inches square PLUS one centre square measuring 21ins x 21 ins.

****these blocks FINISH at 10 ins square and the centre finishes at 20 inches square.

BORDERS

4 strips cut at approx 6 ins x 95 inches.

If using normal-width fabric (42 ins)you can possibly squeeze 4 blocks per width... which means 12 blocks per yard or metre.

Approximately 7 1/2 metres is required using that width.

My quilt is made using a variety of grey linen ... some are striped and some are printed with a subtle motif and some are plain.

Other samples will be shown on plain white or off-white homespun.

CORNERS

For corners of each block use a mix of small geometrics as well as small to medium florals. Small amounts are needed... you can cut 4 little corners from as little as a 6 inch square!

BRODERIE PERSE

Bring motifs you love....they can be repro vintage or contemporary. You can use large motifs in some blocks and small motifs in others.

DOTS

These can be cut from any fabrics but remember to use one fabric consistently in each block. (half metrehalf yard.....required

Dots range from 3/4 ins to 1 1/2 ins. You can use pre-cut dots, Perfect Circles or simply needle turn them.

Saw-tooth border

1 metre.
